AC CNZ Nationals to be held Paraparaumu/Waikanae Clubs 21-25 February 23 inclusive

This prestigious Croquet NZ tournament is to be jointly hosted by Waikanae and Paraparaumu. The lawns will be closed for club play during this time, however there will be some great croquet to watch – so come along and watch.

The tournament is being managed by Tom Berryman and an organising committee which includes Bob McKenzie. Elaine Kirkman attends the Organising Committee meetings to report back to the Committee on our Club's responsibilities in hosting the tournament. Our grounds crew will be keeping the hoops and lawns in good order for the competition.

We are also required to provide kitchen cover for the duration of the tournament and this will be organised in three shifts per day. Upcoming AC tournaments are on the AC Club noticeboard, with the AC Council Cup versus Levin to be held at Paraparaumu on Wednesday 1 February, AC WCA 98th Annual Singles to be held at Waimarie Hutt Valley 4/5 February (entries by 27 January), and AC entries closing for the Veterans handicap tournament to be played on Wednesday 22 February at Plimmerton/Petone. The big event for AC at the Club is of course the AC CNZ Nationals – see above.
