Handicaps	(Also known as Bisquing and/or extra turns)	
	All players will be assigned a CNZ handicap under the Automatic	
	Handicapping System (AHS).	
Handicap Cards	Handicap (AHS) cards are used to keep a record of changes to a	
	player's handicap which are recorded and checked after any	
	competition play. There are separate handicap cards for Golf and	
	Association Croquet. During handicap play your handicap is used to	
	determine how many extra turns you may be entitled to.	
Your Handicap	Your individual handicap is also recorded in the CNZ database, and	
	an updated printout will be on display in the club rooms on one of the	
	noticeboards. For tournaments, please advise the tournament manager	
	of any handicap changes to your card and advise your relevant Club	
	Captain as soon as possible. The database will be updated in a timely	
	manner and handicaps displayed on the noticeboard.	
Coaching	Anne McKenzie Is a CNZ Level 1 coach in both AC and GC.	
	Coaching session maybe arranged through the Club Captains.	

#### INTERCLUB INFORMATION

This is a chance to play in the first part of the season (Oct/Nov) against other clubs. It is a great way of improving your game, playing on other croquet lawns, and meeting other like-minded people.

AHS cards are to be used for all games except for AC double games.

**GC: Sunday** - Teams consist of 2 players, handicap play, 13 hoop games, time limits apply.

Each player plays one game of doubles and 2 games of singles. All games 50 mins + Regulation 9.6.

**GC:** Wednesday - Teams consist of 3 players, levels play, 13 hoop games, time limits apply.

Each player plays 2 games of doubles and 1 game of singles. All games 50 mins + Regulation 9.6.

**AC: Monday afternoons** – Teams of two. Advanced handicap doubles, commencing at 1pm.


